Sealed bids will be received by Prein&Newhof on behalf of Bois Blanc Township, at 3355 Evergreen Dr NE, Grand Rapids, MI 49525, until the bid due time listed above, on the bid due date listed above, at which time and place all bids will be publicly opened and read aloud. **Any bid received after the specified time will not be considered.**

The proposed work includes the following: Rehabilitate Runway 10-28 Pavement, Including Pavement Markings.

Bidder Qualifications

Bidders must submit evidence of qualification meeting the requirements of General Contract Provisions 20-02. Possession by the prime contractor of MDOT prequalification at the time of bidding must be an acceptable form of evidence. In addition, this project includes designated item classifications of “Cb” and “N3”.

If the prime bidder is not prequalified in the designated item classification(s), then it must use a subcontractor that is prequalified in such classification(s). This subcontractor must be designated prior to award of the contract to the confirmed low bidder.

There is a Disadvantage Business Enterprise (DBE) participation goal of (0%) for this project.

A Pre-Bid meeting for this project will be held on **March 13, 2025 at 11:00am** (Local time) at the **Cheboygan County Airport Terminal Building** at 1520 E Levering Rd, Cheboygan, MI 49721. Attendance at the Pre-Bid meeting is not mandatory but is strongly encouraged. Flights may be chartered from Cheboygan County Airport, Mackinac County Airport, and others for those that wish to fly into the airport to view the project area. A Microsoft Teams link will be sent to all prospective bidders on the Official Plan Holders List no later than 24 hours prior to the Prebid meeting.

Bidders may secure copies of the contract documents at www.preinnewhof.com/plan-room or at the Grand Rapids office of Prein&Newhof. Hard copy drawings and specifications are available for the fee of \$125.00. A \$15 charge will be added to all mailed drawings and/or specifications. Fees are payable by cash or check only and are not refunded. Bidder assumes sole risk for any project specifications and drawings, electronic or hard copy, obtained other than directly from Prein&Newhof.

A bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check payable to airport sponsor in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total price must accompany each bid. This surety must bind the bidder for a period of ninety (90) days after the notification of award.

If the selected contractor fails to provide the required materials and/or execute the contract within fifteen (15) calendar days after being furnished with the necessary contract and bond forms, the proposal guaranty will be forfeited to the sponsor in accordance with Section 30-08 of the General Provisions.

Each bidder is individually responsible for the careful examination of the site of the proposed work, the proposal, plans, general provisions, technical specifications, contract forms and all requirements of the project. The failure or omission by any bidder to do so must in no way relieve any bidder from any obligation with respect to its bid.

Bois Blanc Township reserves the following rights: to accept or reject any or all bids; and to award the contract to the most responsive and responsible bidder whose bid is determined by the Bois Blanc Township to be in its best interest.
