## 2. SCOPE OF PROJECT

The project consists of furnishing all material and constructing the following:

360 feet of storm sewer along Bellevue Street from Camburn Street to Lincoln Street.  
Rotomill and resurface pavement from Camburn Street to Lincoln Street.

Including all necessary appurtenances and restoration.

6. BID SURETY

A bid bond, certified check, or cashier's check payable to the City of Stanton in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the total price shall accompany each bid. This surety shall bind the bidder for a period of Ninety (90) days after the receipt of bids.

7. WAGES AND NON-DISCRIMINATION

Attention is called to the fact that not less than the minimum salaries and wages as set forth in the Contract Documents must be paid on this project, and that the Contractor must ensure that employees and applicants for employment are not discriminated against because of their race, color, religion, sex, or national origin.
